## NOTICE OF THE KNYSNA HALFWAY REGATTA AND THE KNYSNA HEADS RACE HOSTED BY WESTERN CAPE ROWING 29th AND 30<sup>TH</sup> OF October 2011

**This notice of regatta is an invitation to all rowing schools/clubs in Southern Africa to participate in the Western Cape Knysna halfway Regatta and Knysna Heads Race as detailed in the notice below.**

- 1. Venue:**  
Knysna Halfway Regatta: Belvidere Estate; Knysna  
Knysna Heads Race: Finish at the Belvidere Estate.
- 2. Date:**  
Knysna Halfway Regatta: Saturday the 29th of October and  
Knysna Heads Race: Sunday the 30<sup>th</sup> of October 2011.
- 3. Course:**  
The Knysna Halfway Regatta Course is a 1km straight course with 4 lanes.  
The Knysna Heads Race will be a 2km unbouyed course.
- 4. Entries:**
  - All entries must be sent to Lana Redman, WCR Secretary ([lanaredman@lanaredman.co.za](mailto:lanaredman@lanaredman.co.za) or [lanabt@iafrica.com](mailto:lanabt@iafrica.com)) strictly before the 18<sup>th</sup> of October 2011.
  - Entrants that have boat preferences must indicate so on entry. All scull events will be held first to make best use of weather conditions. To avoid boat clashes, extra sculls will be available.
  - Cost per entry: (R30.00) per competitor per event including coxes. (To be confirmed!)
  - Any club not having paid by the closing date will not be entered into the final draw.

**5. Refreshments:**

Food, snacks and cool drinks will be available for sale at the venue.

**6. Rules and regulations:**

- The Regatta will be run by WESPRO in terms of rules and laws published in the RowSA rules, available on the website: [www.rowsa.co.za](http://www.rowsa.co.za).
- All rowers entering the Regatta must be registered with RowSA.
- By entering this regatta both the club and rower acknowledge that the entered rower has undergone and passed a sculling test.
- A compulsory traffic rules and safety briefing for all coaches (or delegated person), coxes and rowers of non-coxed boats will be held at 05h45. Roll call will be taken and absence will result in disqualification.
- All boats are to be fitted with heel straps, bow balls and lane numbers, and failure to comply with this rule will result in disqualification.
- The two minute rule will be strictly applied for the duration of the regatta. All issues relating to the programme are to be addressed with the regatta organisers before the Thursday of the regatta.

**7. Prize Giving:**

All Categories will be awarded Medals. The Prize Giving will be held at the end of each days racing.

**8. Adverse Weather Conditions:**

Regatta Control reserves the right to make changes to the racing Programme if the weather creates unfair or unsafe conditions.

**9. Indemnity:**

WCR; RowSA; WESPRO; NSRI and Medical facilities provided do not take responsibility for any damage to property or any bodily injury during the Knysna Halfway Regatta and Knysna Heads Race.
